1. **Who can volunteer at Kathy's House?**

People dedicated to making a difference in the lives of others can volunteer. We accept volunteers from a variety of backgrounds and experience including students, people from the business community, stay-at-home mothers and retirees.

2. **How do I apply to be a volunteer?**

3. **Can I volunteer for a one-time event?**

Yes. Contact the Volunteer Coordinator to discuss details.

4. **Can children volunteer at Kathy's House?**

We do have limited availability for children volunteering at Kathy's House. For additional information Please contact the Volunteer Coordinator.

5. **Are volunteers subject to background checks?**

Yes. To ensure the safety of Kathy's House guests, we conduct background checks on all of our volunteers. Volunteers are not responsible for any costs or fees associated with background checks.

6. **Is there an orientation?**

Yes, all volunteers go through an orientation process that includes learning more about Kathy's House, policies and procedures.

7. **Is there a required commitment?**

We are flexible. However, we would like all of our volunteers to help at the House at least once a month.

8. **Are volunteer hours flexible?**

Yes. We work with your schedule

9. **What should I wear when I volunteer?**

Casual wear is fine. Clothes should be in good condition and appropriate for volunteering.

10. **I would like to make a meal. How many guests should I prepare for?**

We ask that you prepare enough food to accommodate 20-25 guests. Leftovers are always appreciated!

11. Can I stay and have dinner with the guests?

Absolutely, we encourage you to sit and have dinner with our guests.

12. Where do I park when I arrive?

Volunteers can park in the front and on the side of Kathy's House. Please note that there is only one hour parking on the street.
